

Collegiate Foundation Ambassador

The expectation of a Foundation Ambassador is to be passionate and willing to advocate for Tri Sigma Foundation's mission, including our philanthropic partnership with March of Dimes. Ambassadors will be responsible for working closely with Foundation staff and volunteers to support its annual philanthropy and service opportunities. All Ambassadors are expected to work together to fundraise and engage undergraduate members through scholarship, leadership development and Sigma Serves Children.

Eligibility:

- Completed at least two undergraduate semesters prior to the 2019-2020 academic school year.
- Minimum GPA of 2.75
- Will not graduate prior to May 2020
- Demonstrates leadership within chapter and/or on campus.
- Ability to share why one gives and/or supports the Foundation's mission.

Expectations:

- Ambassador must remain in good standing with collegiate chapter
- Responsibilities will include monthly conference calls, fundraising for the Foundation, and promoting philanthropic initiatives
- Demonstrate a willingness to partner with chapter Foundation Chair to support philanthropy education and service opportunities
- Support the Foundation with a minimum annual gift of \$18.98
- Be a spokeswoman via social media, philanthropy events, recruitment, etc. and serve as a role model for collegiate involvement with the Foundation.
- Collaborate with Ambassador team virtually to execute fundraiser(s) and manage social media accounts
- Maintain confidentiality with donor information

Because Foundation Ambassadors will be communicating with Foundation supporters and potential donors, members should be well-spoken, demonstrate leadership skills and comfortable with technology.
