- Collaborate with the Enablement Department to create and deliver civic engagement and advocacy programming.
- Encourage members to be leaders in their schools and communities and provide best practices for meaningful engagement.
- Create, update, and maintain a platform for direct, continuous engagement with key sisters who can serve as influencers in civic engagement and advocacy efforts.
- Time commitment: 5-10 hours per month.
- This role is a part of a **Standing Committee**, formed to do designed work on an ongoing basis. Term ends when volunteer chooses to resign, fails to meet expectations, or if the goals of the committee are determined to no longer meet the organization's needs.
